To work on improving the water quality, a major challenge for the population Maïsadour signed on Thursday, the 11th of January 2024, the "Re.Sources" contract, a project submitted by the EMMA (Eaux Marensin Maremne Adour) water syndicate, to protect the water resource on the catchment area of Orist (Landes). This contract involving many players and partners was signed with Madam Tahérie, Prefect of the Landes. It establishes a 4-year roadmap with regular exchanges between the partners.

The players of the region get mobilized for a sustainable management of the water

In October 2023, The Adour Garonne Water Agency validated the strategy, the actions to implement and the objectives of the Orist Territorial Action Plan and the funding and involvement of each of the partners.

Afterwards, all the partners and reference institutions mobilized to endorse the commitments contract. Thursday the 11th of January 2024, EMMA (Eaux Marensin Maremne Adour) invited the partners involved in the contract for a visit of the EMMA institution in Orist that was followed by the signing of the contract at the town hall of Saint Vincent de Tyrosse. The parties involved in this contract should gather soon in order to detail roadmap that will allow to implement the actions considered for the next 4 years.

Christophe Bonno, Executive Director of Maïsadour: "For more than 10 years, Maïsadour has been committed in the management of the water resource, an essential element for the proper development of our plant and animal productions. We are constantly looking for new practices, tools and strategy to optimize our water needs and preserve its quality. This partnership goes in the right direction, Maïsadour will be there during the whole action plan of this contract."

Various experiments to initiate some changes of practices

Since 2011, Maïsadour has been carrying some experiments in the Orist watershed with a dozen farmers and two main partners: the Chamber of Agriculture of the Landes which supports the farmers and provides its regulatory expertise, and the CUMA for the loan of agricultural equipment. The Group and the volunteer farmers for various tests of cultivation practices: mechanical or mixed weeding, implementation of plant cover on the plots, simplified soil work. These experiments were led by pilot farmers, committed for a, agroecological transition of the agriculture.

Thus, each year, the teams of Maïsadour and the farmers involved organize some demonstration days with other farmers to present the results of these experiments and initiate new changes of practice.

The LICORN offer of Vega*Maïsadour: a targeted input management in the field

Launched at the end of 2022, Vega*Maïsadour is the new brand of the Plant Business Line of the Cooperative, dedicated to the farmers and industries. Through soil and sap analyses, the farmers will be supported by a precise interpretation of their crop needs (nitrogen, trace elements, deficiencies, excess, etc.). Thus, the farmers have a more efficient fertilizing strategy, emitting less greenhouse gases and that preserves more the quality of the water found in the soils. Risk management, new fertilizers, decarbonization, this offer allows to initiate a change of practice for the farmers, supported by the Vega*Maïsadour experts who are securing the changes of practice while maintaining the agronomic performances of the farmers.
